

Updates re COVID-19 Omicron Variant:

- The Omicron variant, identified on November 24 and named on November 26, 2021, has now been detected in many different countries, including Israel and the United States.
- So far, it has been linked to a significant upsurge in infections in South Africa (see below), though it will take time to determine whether its impact on hospitalizations and deaths is different than that of the predominant delta variant.



Ohio This Week: average daily cases near 7K, deaths ~50, positivity ~20%. Average daily hospitalizations are at the highest level since January 2021, and many hospitals in the region are reporting that they are at or beyond capacity.


