Fuchs Mizrachi School Community Pledge

By affirming this pledge, I acknowledge that:

- I have had the opportunity to review all of the Fuchs Mizrachi School's COVID-19 related policies, and have been provided with contact information for the school administration and medical advisory committee (medical@fuchsmzirachi.org) to resolve any questions.
- Each member of my family has a primary care physician with whom we can discuss all of our personal health care concerns.
- I am aware that COVID-19 is a highly contagious disease that is easily transmitted, even during casual social contact.
- I am aware that it is impossible to **eliminate** the risk of transmitting this disease in any environment where people physically interact, including a school building; however it is possible to minimize the risk by carefully and consistently following the school's guidelines.
 - By following these guidelines, I make everyone at Mizrachi safer.
 - By ignoring a guideline, I put everyone at risk.
- Medical knowledge about this disease is constantly changing, and we may need to adjust our practices based on new information.
- Violation of any of my commitments to the Mizrachi community is grounds for suspension or dismissal from school.

By affirming this pledge, I commit that I and every member of my household will consistently follow all of the following guidelines, in and out of school, including:

- Immediately disclosing to the Mizrachi administration if I or any member of my family has:
 - Been confirmed or presumed to be infected with COVID-19.
 - Had close contact with any presumed or confirmed case.
- Wearing a proper face covering whenever we are in a public setting, consistent with State and local requirements.
- Maintaining proper social distancing, at all times, from anyone who is not a member of my household.
 - This includes sitting or standing in close proximity, hugging, kissing, high five/shaking hands, sharing food or sharing a phone, computer or other device.
 - I will not attend or, if present, remain at any event or gathering where these guidelines are being widely violated.
- Practicing proper hand hygiene at all times, including frequent hand washing and use of proper hand sanitizer.
- Adhering to the State of Ohio's guidelines regarding travel to other states or countries that are considered high risk. This includes following self-quarantine recommendations after returning from those locations. (You can find updated information on travel advisory https://coronavirus.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/covid-19/families-and-individuals/covid-19travel-advisory/covid-19-travel-advisory.)





- Receiving all recommended childhood immunizations prior to the start of the school year and arranging with my child's primary care provider to catch up on any vaccinations that have been delayed due to the pandemic.
- Receiving an influenza vaccination for the 2020-2021 flu season within 6 weeks of the date that the vaccine first becomes available.
- Not entering the school building or sending my child to school if I or they:
 - o Have had a fever (temperature > 100.4 F) within the past 72 hours.
 - Have taken a medication (such as Tylenol or Motrin) for the purpose of reducing fever.
 - Have any symptoms listed in the official Mizrachi policy.
 - Have tested positive for SARS-COV-2, the virus that causes COVID19 (until the required guarantine has been completed).
 - Have been in close contact with anyone presumed or confirmed to be infected with COVID19.
 - Have attended any large gathering where appropriate infection control and social distancing measures were not followed. This may include private parties, restaurants or bars.
- Picking up my child within 30 minutes of being contacted if my child develops symptoms suspicious for COVID 19 during the school day.
- Cooperating with all local, state and public health agencies if a presumed or confirmed case of COVID19 is detected within the Mizrachi community. This includes:
 - Providing complete and truthful information to contact tracers. This includes the names of any individuals who have been at any gatherings that I have attended.
 - Adhering to all recommendations regarding isolation, quarantine and return to school.
 - Submitting to testing if asked to do so.
